We offer them in this encounter with God, we enter into relationship with Him wholeheartedly, to meet Him who welcomes us and renews in us the desire to share the Love of His Heart:

In prayer we come to Him with everything that touches our life, with the sufferings and hopes of humanity. We learn to remain in silence and poverty of heart before Him. In the free gift of ourselves we learn to adore and to abide in His love.


Prophesy! Out of the four winds come, O Spirit, to revive hope in us!

The word of the Lord is able to reignite the fire of God's Spirit within us. Where we see only the dry bones- our wounds, our sins- there we need to invite the One who comforts and revives hope. God Himself invites us to do this because, as the Source of Life, He desires to bring us back to life and gradually transform us.

The Spirit of Jesus offers us the gift of transformation of heart, but it is not for us only. Authentic "transformation is the fruit of the Encounter" ("Life Unfolding..."), which brings us out of ourselves and towards the others. Love always sets us in motion because it desires to be known and loved. Listening to the people we live with invites us to pray and to care for each other with hope, gentleness, and strength, so that we learn from one another, encourage, forgive, console, give courage to choose life.

Do you call for the Holy Spirit in your daily life? Which of your relationships, what part of your reality invites you to cry out to God's Spirit and revive hope?

"I will bring you out of your graves, my people, and I will lead you...".





