SINCE FEBRUARY 24, WHEN RUSSIA ATTACKED UKRAINE, WE REALIZE MORE AND MORE HOW HORRIFYING IS THIS WAR FOR THE UKRAINIAN PEOPLE AND HOW THREATENING IT IS FOR THE WHOLE WORLD. THE ESCALATION OF CONFLICT IN UKRAINE HAS FORCED PEOPLE TO FLEE THEIR HOMES SEEKING SAFETY, PROTECTION AND ASSISTANCE.





REALIZE THE SCALE OF UKRAINIAN HEROISM



GENERAL SITUATION REVIEW (FIVE WEEKS INTO THE WAR)

- INITIAL RAPID GAINS OF THE RUSSIAN FORCES
- THE GOAL OF TAKING THE CONTROL OVER KYIEV AND REINSTALLING A DEPENDENT GOVERNMENT WITHIN A WEEK FAILED.
- UKRAINIANS ARE FIGHTING BACK IN SEVERAL LOCATIONS.
- ATTACKS ON UKRAINIAN CIVIL INFRASTRUCTURE, E.G. APARTMENT BUILDINGS, FACTORIES, SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS.
- GRAVE HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN MARIUPOL.
- AT LEAST 1179 UKRAINIAN CIVILIAN KILLED AND 1860 INJURED (ACCORDING TO OHCHR);
- UKRAINE SUFFERED \$565 BILLION IN DAMAGES AND LOSSES (UKRAINIAN ECONOMY MINISTER DATA).

INFORMATION WAR

- DEFINITION: MANIPULATION OF INFORMATION TRUSTED BY A TARGET WITHOUT THE TARGET'S AWARENESS SO THAT THE TARGET WILL MAKE DECISIONS AGAINST THEIR INTEREST.
- CYBERWARFARE WITH ELEMENTS OF PROPAGANDA (DISINFORMATION, FAKE NEWS), DEMORALIZATION, DISTRACTION, POLITICAL POSTURING.
- RF GOVERNMENT GROUPS CREATED FAKE PERSONAS ON SOCIAL MEDIA (E.G. FACEBOOK), TO DISSEMINATE RUSSIAN NARRATIVES
- EXAMPLES: UKRAINE IS NOT A REAL COUNTRY BUT HAS ALWAYS BEEN PART OF RUSSIA, US IS OPERATING A BIOCHEMICAL LABORATORY WITHIN UKRAINE, UKRAINIAN TRY TO BUILD A SO-CALLED DIRTY (NUCLEAR) BOMB, UKRAINIAN REFUGEES WERE ATTACKING POLES AFTER FLEEING THE WAR ZONE, UKRAINIAN REFUGEES GET LARGER SOCIAL HELP THEN POLISH (IN POLAND)



LARGEST REFUGEE CRISIS SINCE WORLD WAR II



- NEARLY 10.3 MILLION PEOPLE FORCIBLY DISPLACED WITHIN UKRAINE AND NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES
- 3.8 M HAVE FLED UKRAINE
- NEARLY 2.3 M UKRAINIANS HAVE ARRIVED IN POLAND (INCLUDING APPROX. 1.1 M CHILDREN)
- OF THOSE MORE THAN 1.5 M REMAIN

- Hungary deeply sympathises with the people of Ukraine.
 When the war broke out, we immediately opened the borders to refugees, first spontaneously and then, increasingly organised, with an intensive reception.
- In the first days, reception points were opened in border settlements, then in railway stations in Budapest. Currently, the largest aid point is in Budapest (300 km from the border), with government support.
- The government provides all the support (money, logistics, health, accommodation, etc.). Charitable organisations (Caritas, Malta, Red Cross are also active, some NGOs. Parishes have opened their community centres, schools have opened their gyms. Families also take in refugees, mostly women with children, practically without luggage. They also organise school activities for the children. There is sick care. Everyone is provided with accommodation. Students can continue their studies for free in the universities too.



As we are a small country and our language (Hungarian) is very specialised, we are not a destination country for refugees, most of them continue their journey to Western Europe or America. Those who stay are Hungarian speakers, many of whom have already taken jobs (in factories, grocery stores, small companies, in the IT sector or as doctors.)

- Hungarians are very generous and active in helping. Both at the institutional level and at the civil level. The churches are also present.
- Challenge: language (Ukrainians and Hungarians cannot communicate in a common language). Appropriate professionals to coordinate. In some places (train stations) it would be good to have a single help system, sometimes there are too many volunteers.
- We are preparing for the situation to persist in the long term.
- Hungary does not ask for money, all aid organisations receive plenty from the state to take care of the refugees.





 Where financial assistance is needed: the Hungarian-inhabited parts of Transcarpathia in Ukraine. They live in great poverty, but are currently stable. There are many Ukrainian refugees from the war zone who do not want to leave the country. They are welcomed here by the Hungarian minority. They are on a tight financial budget.


