INTRODUCTION

On May 24, 2025, the Society of the Sacred Heart of Jesus celebrates the centenary of the canonization of its founder, Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat. On this occasion, the laity and nuns of the Sacred Heart Family wish to share with as many people as possible her impetus, her inspiring figure of holiness for today.

"Madeleine Sophie Barat's life simply expresses the fact that 'the world can change from the heart'. This woman, born in 1779 in a world in search of new reference points, discovered the Heart of Jesus as the source of spiritual and social rebirth. Steeped in austere Jansenism as a child, she was drawn in by God's compassionate love and gave herself entirely to Him. One of the pioneers of girls' education, she had the intuition of an integral formation that starts from the interiority to grasp the whole person and engage her in the transformation of the world. THREE CELEBRATIONS TO REMEMBER

24/05 2025

Saturday, May 24, 2025 in Joigny

Birthplace of Saint Madeleine Sophie

3:30pm - Eucharist of the centenary of her canonization at Saint Thibault church, presided over by Mgr Pascal Wintzer, Bishop of Sens-Auxerre.

Blessing and official naming of the chapel where she was baptized "Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat".

Followed by a festive shared meal and a vigil of adoration led by young people at the Centre spirituel Sophie Barat (birthplace).

24/05 2025

Saturday, May 24, 2025 in Rome

At Trinité-des-Monts, where Saint Madeleine Sophie lived

4:00 pm - Lecture by Julien Bechard, archivist, teacher and researcher on "Sacred Heart spirituality from Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat to Saint Thérèse of the Infant Jesus (canonized a week before Madeleine Sophie)

5:00 p.m. - Eucharist for the centenary of the canonization presided over by Father Fabrice du Haÿs, rector of Trinité-des-Monts

6:00 pm - Veneration of the relics of Saint Madeleine Sophie

7:00 pm -Sacred Heart Choir with Maestro Osvaldo Guidotti

Followed by an aperitif



Friday, June 27, 2025 in Paris

In the church of Saint-François-Xavier, where the body of Saint Madeleine Sophie lies.

6:45 pm - Solemnity of the Sacred Heart Mass Presided over by Mgr Bruno Lefèvre-Pontalis, parish priest of Saint-François-Xavier, on the closing day of the jubilee year of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart to Saint Marguerite-Marie Alacoque at Paray-le-Monial. Followed by an aperitif

Proposed by lay people and nuns of the Sacré-Coeur on the occasion of the feast and centenary of the canonization of Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat.

WHY THIS PRAYER

In this "Pilgrims of Hope" Jubilee Year 2025 of the Universal Church and on the impetus of Pope Francis' latest encyclical on the Sacred Heart of Jes<u>us</u>, "Dilexit Nos (He has loved us)", discover, invoke, let yourself be inspired by Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat: she who, leaning on the Heart of Jesus, knew how to get through trials and make her contribution to a Church and a world undergoing profound changes.

By praying this novena, follow her example and draw from the Heart of Jesus the source of an enlightened faith, at the service of others and the integral education of the person.

A DEEPLY-ROOTED SPIRITUAL JOURNEY

Every day for 9 days:

- A meditation to draw inspiration from a feature of Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat's human and spiritual life (with quotations, biographical details and evangelical words).
- A prayer to the Heart of Jesus and to Saint Madeleine Sophie (a prayer of intercession).
- A commitment to live it today.

On November 21, 1800, Madeleine Sophie Barat, a 20-yearold from Burgundy, made her first consecration in Paris. In a society turned upside down by the Revolution, the love of Christ led this young woman of unusual cultural background to found an Ignatian-inspired congregation whose aim was to discover and reveal the love of the Heart of Christ.

- Focusing on the most disadvantaged;
- Offering spiritual guidance through conversations and retreats based on the Exercises of St. Ignatius.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat at Notre-Dame de Paris

Sunday December 8, 2024, marked the reopening of Notre-Dame de Paris Cathedral and, during the mass consecrating the new main altar, the relics of Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat were placed in cathedral's main altar, alongside four other saints whose history is linked to the Church of Paris. The ceremony was presided over by the Archbishop of Paris, Mgr Laurent Ulrich, in the presence of the President of the Republic, Emmanuel Macron. Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat was honored as a witness to the joyful reopening of "this common house, where each and every one, and above all the smallest and poorest, have their place." Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat in Saint Peter's Basilica, Rome

Following her canonization on May 24, 1925 by Pope Pius XI in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, a statue was erected representing Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat. The statue, created in 1934 by sculptor Enrico Quattrini, greets pilgrims in the nave of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome as they enter on the right, above Saint Teresa of Avila, who was very dear to her.

Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat in the church of Saint-François-Xavier, Paris

The body of Saint Madeleine Sophie Barat, which has remained intact, can be venerated in the chapel on the Sacré-Coeur of the Saint-François-Xavier church in Paris, adjacent to where Madeleine Sophie lived and died. Her shrine was installed there in 2019 during the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, presided over by Cardinal André Vingt-Trois, Archbishop of Paris. An interactive terminal allows visitors to place intentions, to discover Madeleine Sophie, and soon they will be able to interact via a chatbot.
